

## THE GENUS *SCLERIA* IN COLOMBIA

Since the publication of my revision of the American species of the genus *Scleria* (\*), continued field work and herbarium studies have brought to light numerous new distributional records for Colombia. In particular, the explorations of Dr. José Cuatrecasas, and of numerous botanists on the staff of the Foreign Economic Administration have resulted in the discovery of several species new to Colombia and at least one new to science.

The type locality of *S. macrophylla* was recorded as "in insula Luzon" but Merrill pointed out (*Enum. Philip. Fl. Pl. P:* 136. 1923) that it does not resemble any known Philippine species and my examination of Presl's type showed that it is the same as the American plant that had passed as *S. paludosa*. Evidently Presl's geographic data had been mixed.
